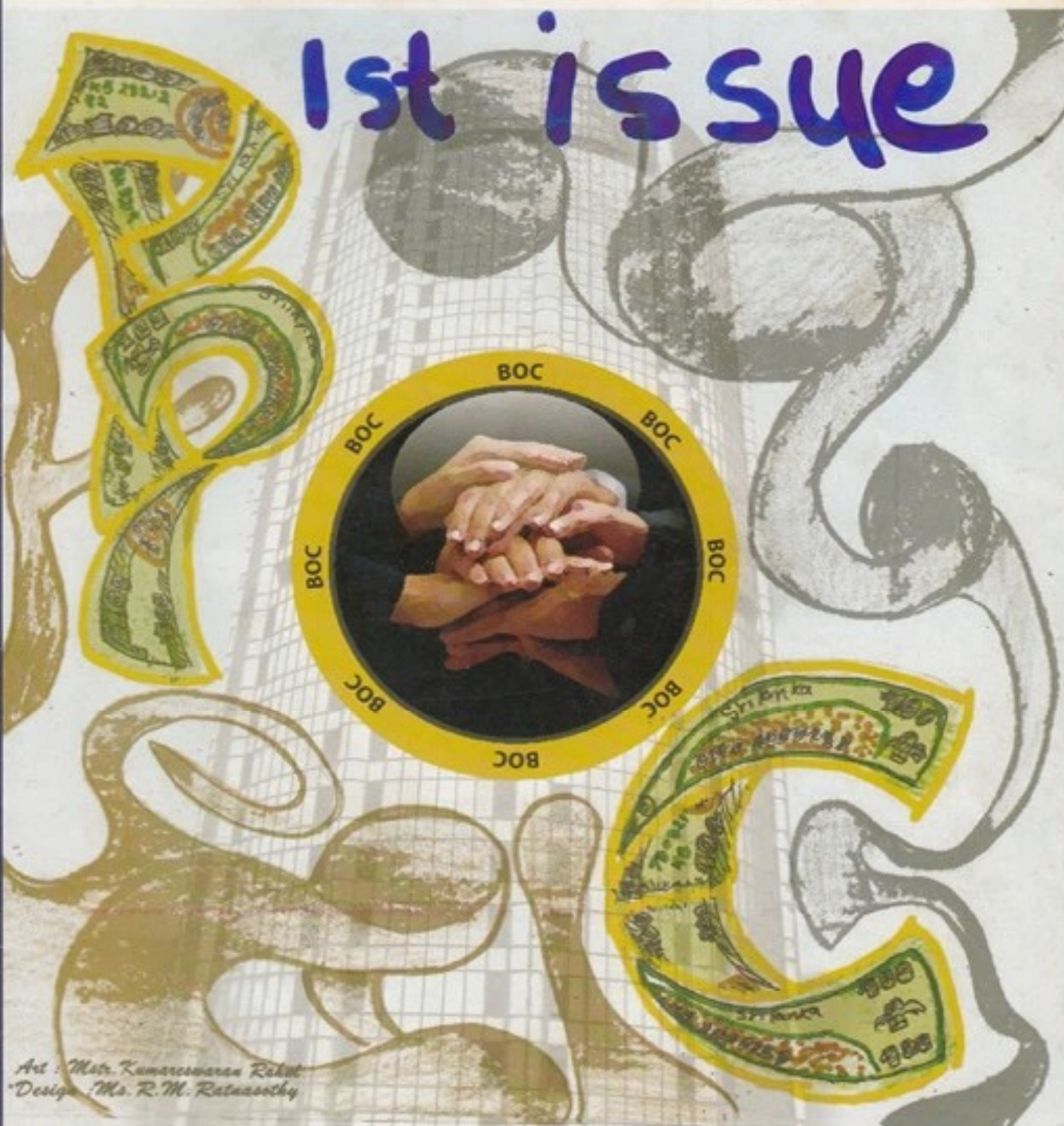

REPORT OF THE PAST PRESIDENT

As everyone knows, the situation of the Jaffna district cannot be compared with that of any other district in Sri Lanka. The period between the years 2002-2006 appeared a bit normal due to the then prevailing peace accord. However, check points, transport restrictions and other constraints for the normal civil life existed. Therefore, we could not organize an effective pensioners' association for a long time. We could not even get the pensioners in the district to assemble at a common place to conduct the annual general meeting and elect office bearers.



However, with the assistance of the parent association, we elected the office bearers in June 2007. But we could not have a meeting. Instead, telephone and other means of communications were used to contact available pensioners in order to elect the office bearers. This itself shows the then prevailing situation which prevented most of the aged pensioners to travel out of home.

At this point I wish to place on record the services of Mr. A. Rasanayagam who did his best to organize the Branch Association, at least in the year 2007. He also was unanimously elected as the secretary and did a yeoman service.

Subsequently, in the year 2008 also, the same office bearers were unanimously elected in April 2008. Activities of the association were very limited due to the mobility of the pensioners. In any case committee meetings were held at irregular intervals.

we did not even have an office to conduct our meetings. We are indeed thankful to the A.G.M.s who were in service during those years especially

M/SB.A.Arumainayagam and N. Sivaratnam, who made available their office or the quarters to conduct our meetings.

We are also thankful to Mr. K. Anantharajah, the retired A.G.M. of the Peoples Bank, who also assisted us in one or two occasions by allowing us to utilize their auditorium.

Mr.K. Kaneshamoorthy should have a special mention here as he is the pioneer for several beneficial aspects for the pensioners including the formation of the association and the coordination he had with the Branch Association with the parent body.

In the year 2009 , the same office bearers were unanimously elected. By that time the war was almost coming to an end and the situation too began to ease , thereby enabling the pensioners to move about without much constraints in travel and transport.

In the year 2010, we had a successful A.G.M .where several pensioners participated and the new office bearers were elected

From the foregoing you all will appreciate the fact that the period between 2007 and 2009 did not have much activities. Although we kept the association going amidst several odds. We can even call the said period as a dormant period for the association due to the then prevailing situation.

After the end of 2009 and also the end of the war which coincided, the association began to see a new dawn which boosted the activities with more coordination with the parent body and also the visit of the president and other office bearers of the parent association to Jaffna.

My special thanks are also to the present A.G.M. (N.P) Mr.K.E.D.Sumanasiri who made arrangements to allocate an office space to our association with basic furnitures.

I hope that ,with the developments that have already taken place ,our association will march forward triumphantly for the mutual benefit of the pensioners and our bank in general

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

The Bank of Ceylon, Pensioners' Association holds a very special place among the Pensioners of Jaffna District as a whole & the Bank retirees in particular.

From the inception our association has achieved many objectives & passed many a milestone in its path I am careful not to duplicate many achievements & happenings of importance which are already chronicled in the secretary's report.



But as a person who was associated closely with both the Northern Province Bank pensioners welfare association (which is a predecessor to our present association) & with the Bankers Association of Jaffna, I want to pen a few events & experiences which I trust will be of interest to the new generations & for those who may not be aware of the past history. This message may be the past history of Banking industry in Northern Province.

The Bankers Association Jaffna District first came into existence during the IPKF period of 1987 to 1989 to co ordinate Banks functions during these troubled times when various armed groups interfered in the smooth functioning of the Banks with one group prohibiting the opening of banks on certain days of the week while an opposing group threatened the managers & key holding officers to open on all days. Further the Indian Peace Keeping Force on their part took key holding officers & staff in their vehicles by force and ordered to open the Banks & work.

Thus the managers & Key holding officers of the banks were under great pressure. The managers & higher executive officers of all banks unofficially met periodically to discuss & co-ordinate Banking operations in Jaffna.

The Bankers Association of Jaffna (not the pensioners association) was officially inaugurated in 1992 with all officers of all the banks in Jaffna namely of BOC, People's Bank, Commercial Bank, HNB & NSB which were eligible to join

The objectives of this association are:

- 1. To felicitate Bank Pensioners, yearly*
- 2. To Sort out common problems faced by Bankers with I P K F, police, armed forces such as transport difficulties, restrictions in banking activities, curfews & Civil war situation etc.*

3. To conduct classes for aspiring students in banking which was arranged at Jaffna College under graduate section at Hospital Road, Jaffna

The pensioners association was formed initially as Northern Province Banks' pensioners' welfare association comprising BOC, Peoples Bank & all other Banks retirees and this was officially inaugurated on 30-09-1994 having its office at room no-12, 1st floor, KUMARAN INN Stanley road Jaffna that was arranged by me as a rent free office.

The objectives are

1. To honour & award token gifts to children of Bankers & ex Bankers who have passed scholarship examination & for those who obtained best results in GCE O/L & A/L Examinations as well as to Bank employees who have completed Bankers Training Institute Exam (A.I.B) now known as Diploma in Banking & Finance (D.B.F)
2. To closely associate with the Bankers' Association of Jaffna District
3. To honour the employees who have obtained Degrees, Master Degrees etc, in Recognized Universities. In the year 2003/2004 Mr.V.Arulanantham, the then manager NSB Jaffna was awarded a special prize for his Master Degree in economics.

The Association also periodically selected "THE OUTSTANDING BANK EMPLOYEE" and felicitated them. In this way, as per my memory the following employees were felicitated.

I can't Forget Mr. K. Ganeshamoorthy, the then Area Manager BOC, Jaffna District who was instrumental in inaugurating both these associations with his untiring efforts. I am proud that I had been associating with him from the beginning & became president of the Bankers Association Jaffna District in the Year 2008, after having served in various capacities.

In the last annual general meeting in 2011 Mr. S. N. Manikkasinghe Senior Manager, Bank of Ceylon, Northern Province & Mr. V. Arulanantham Zonal Manager N.S.B, North East, were elected President & Secretary respectively. It is expected by all the senior bankers to meet their friends in the annual felicitation conducted by this association.

A Regional Centre of IBSL was established in the year 2002 as a result of repeated efforts of our association and with the great assistance extended by the authorities of Jaffna College which was the one and the only accredited Institute accepted by the chartered institute of Bankers London that issues the Certificates to the successful candidates. It is open for bankers and non bankers. Yearly 100 150 students appear for their exams and the 10th anniversary of the successful achievements are to be celebrated in March 2012.

These are my personal experiences & reminiscences due to my long association with both of these associations. Now the management of Bank of Ceylon & Peoples Bank wanted to have separate association for each bank. We are part of the Bank of Ceylon Pensioners' Parent Association with head office in Colombo & all pensioners are automatic members of association of the respective Province/District. I take this opportunity to thank the chief manager BOC Jaffna, the AGM Northern Province, our parent association and the management for allocating a rent free office which was officially inaugurated at Jaffna Super grade Branch, on 1st August 2011 coinciding with the 72nd anniversary of BOC.

Our Jaffna District Branch has a membership of 133 in the year 2011 which is the second highest in the country behind Colombo. However it is to be noted that efforts are to be taken by all interested parties to form a similar association in Vanni District which is the only one without a District association.

Now the duties of our association are as follows:

1. DEPOSIT MOBILIZATION

Contribution to deposit mobilization of the Bank in order to maintain the market share & the number one position.

2. SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

To contribute our mite towards social obligations by visiting Hospitals, Mental asylums, Refugees Camps & Home for the aged and comforting the inmates.

Especially we have to make it a point to visit our friends who are confined to their Residences due to illness for a long period

3. FELICITATION OF SENIOR BANKERS

Honouring selected Senior Bankers in a fitting manner in appreciation of their Past services

SOME OTHER FEATURES

- a) *Special Problem that is facing the district is how to assist employees who have retired without pension*
- b) *The parent body is quietly approaching & pressuring the BOC Management for an upward revision of pension which is long overdue.*
- c) *Reciprocating affected pensioners:- A memorandum dated 28th may 2011 was sent to the general manager of BOC and other respective authorities to reciprocate the pensioners who have contributed their best during the most turbulent time but there has been no response yet (please find the memorandum on another page)*

The new upgraded pensioners & widows pensioners medical assistance 2010 scheme is a recent achievement of the parent association.

Now moves are afoot to make amendments to the constitution & to change the name of the association as "BOC RETIRED EMPLOYEES SOCIETY LTD."

Discussions in all district associations are taking place. The pensioners will be notified in due course after adoption of the change in the constitution at forth coming annual general meeting.

Another milestone:- SPORTS, WELFARE AND ART & LITERARY ASSOCIATION BANK OF CEYLON JAFFNA DISTRICT.

It is also relevant to mention here that a "BOC District Sports Club" in the above name was formed by my initiative in the year 2006 comprising all the BOC employees in Jaffna District.

The objectives were,

1. *To conduct sports affairs in District and Provincial level.*
2. *To honour periodically, all the retiring employees of the Jaffna district in a common forum.*
3. *To honour the children and bank employees who have excelled in their studies and career development respectively.*
4. *To release a journal i.e. The Catalyst (කැටලිස්ට්) in order to highlights the banking events and also to publish articles that are useful to students, under graduates and bank employees for their job test.*

These journals have been released quarterly from April 2007 to 2009. This was appreciated by our head office and there is a mention about "Catalyst" in the second volume of

"EXPANDING HORIZONS" 6TH & 7TH decades of Bank of Ceylon.

However it is regrettable that this association is now defunct, therefore action is to be taken to reactivate same.

I also take this opportunity to express my sincere gratitude to the general members, committee members, general councilors and the past president for having extended their full support and co-operation.

Wishing all pensioners and present employees of BOC for a better future.

Pensioners who toiled for the Banks (State & Private) during turbulent periods


We pensioners of the Northern Province are breathing a sigh of relief as a perennial war that continued unabated for almost 3 decades has finally ceased. Hence we who worked for our banks tirelessly during turbulent times think that the time is now appropriate to place before the managing boards of all banks concerned, our humble submissions requesting a reasonable increase to our pensions or at least a reasonable compensation for discharging our duties to the entire satisfaction of the respective management :-

1. We served the public when other public institutions ceased to function.
2. There was an acute shortage of liquid cash. However we succeeded in serving our customers satisfactorily with the assistance of traders and corporate customers.
3. Despite the fact that there was no electricity and other facilities we posted the ledgers manually and Served the customers.
4. It is pertinent to mention that some of our employees perished or were badly injured due to bombing, shelling or cross fire.
5. We underwent untold hardships to travel to Colombo for official or other urgent purposes due to lack of proper transport facilities, closure of roads etc.
6. Several pensioners could not get their legitimate promotion due to the inability of sitting for the examinations, internal and external and / or appearing for interviews etc.
7. The installments on loans obtained under the Bank's housing loan scheme against mortgaged properties had been periodically paid and out standings fully settled even out of retirement benefits of many pensioners, despite the fact that their houses and properties were either completely destroyed or badly damaged and beyond repairs. In some instances, pensioners were compelled to settle the loan without any concessions on properties on which they have no access as they are inside the high security zone.

The problems mentioned are just a few whereas the trials and tribulations we faced were too numerous to mention. We therefore make an impassioned plea to the management of all banks to consider us, the pensioners, most of whom are old and feeble and inflicted with incurable diseases such as diabetes, hypertension, paralysis and needing constant medication, to be compensated adequately and appeal for interalia the under mentioned remedies :-

1. To place all the pensioners who worked during turbulent period, one grade above their grades at the time of retirement which will be a real and faithful reward for the yeomen services rendered by them to the bank and the nation.
2. To pay appropriate compensation for the damages and losses of properties suffered by the pensioners

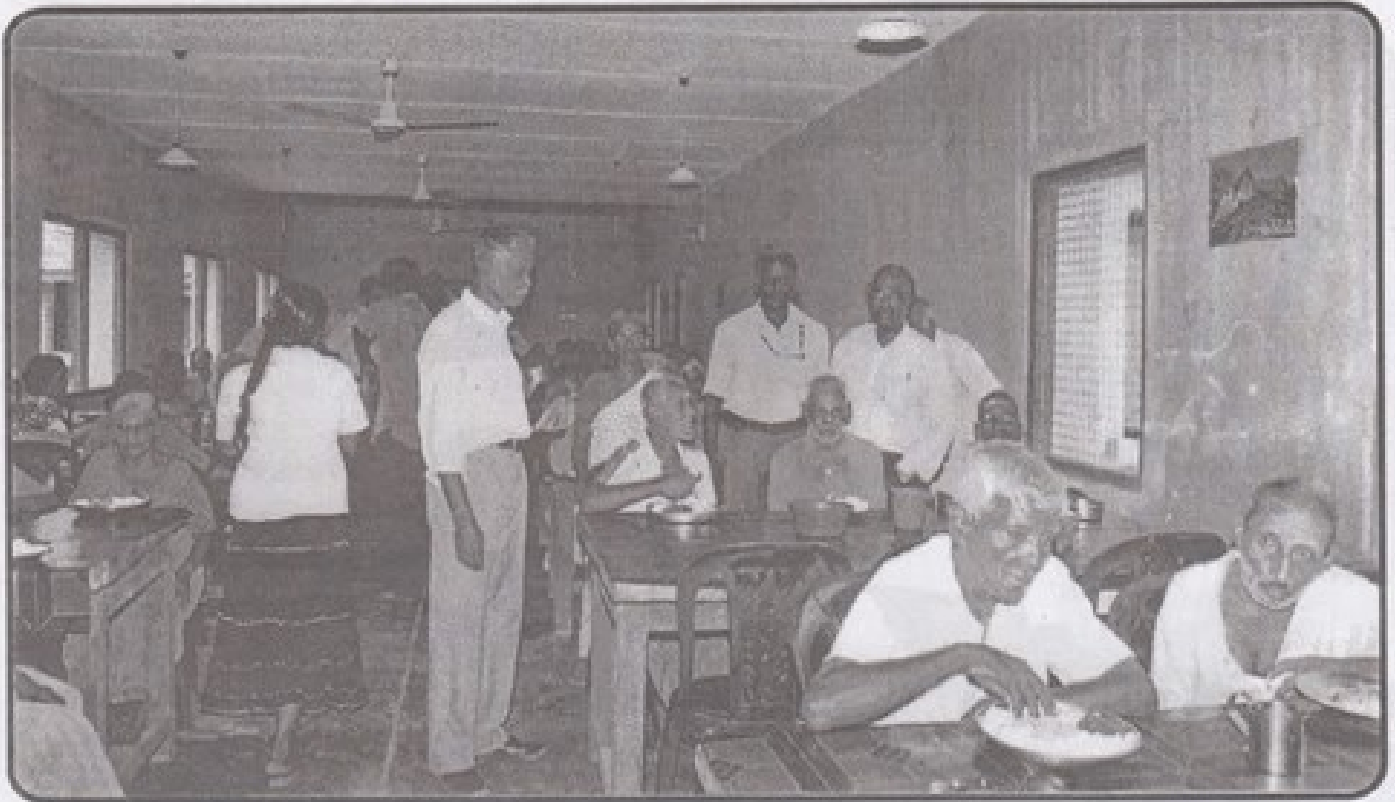

Reminiscencing Persons and Events of Interest at Jaffna Branch of the Sixties.

On being posted to Jaffna from pettah as from January 1964, I could remember walking in to the branch with some hesitancy only to find my curlier manager Mr. A.B. Rajasingham, that big made, hurly burly tall unusually fair handsome lovable personality with an attractive commanding voice seated in the manager's room. Unlike in Colombo offices, I found in Jaffna the manager was being held on a very high pedestal, so much so that before he decides as to whom to call with an Ahah,...." there would be more than a couple of loyal ones right at his feet, and by the time he completes the whole heap of staff would be gazing at his direction from all corners of the building.

there was a gathering of officers all known by 'Aiyahs' after their names instead of messers before their names like thuraisamy Aiyah, the Asst. Manager, Weerasekaram Aiyah and Sabapthypillai Aiyah the ledger officers, Shroff Kathiravetpillai Aiyah and one or two other Aiyahs my memory fails to remember, that made a happy band rallying round to the manager.

While walking to office on my second day to work, I was almost along side with Thuraismy Aiyah when through courtesy wished him " Good Morning Aiyah' for which there was no response and presuming that he had not heard me, repeated my greetings again at which he turned at me and made a sign with his hands as if to say "Ok Ok" without uttering a word. Having entered the bank he was seen immediately setting the combination of the vault and with the click of the combination lock, he turned round beaming with a smile called for the "new boy" and wished me good morning good morning" It transpired later that the manager had left for the KKS Airport pay office on a surprise inspection that morning and had handed over the vault keys to his assistant on his way so that work would commence as usual. The combination numbers as a rule then should not be kept written and this pious character had religiously memorised the numbers like a parrot. Earing that the numbers would slip through his lips if he had opened his mouth to greet me back had kept himself mum till as such time he had set the combination to greet me back and that is how I received a ten minutes late return greetings!

Sabapathypillai Aiyah was known as a slightly moody character and had his way if the manager was not around and would very often try to target Thuraisamy Aiyah with his hecklings and gimmicks knowing well that the senior was a soft character. It so happened that one day the manager had left for the Airport early and Sam, as our hero was known at times, sensing the absence of the manager became rather boisterous and demands that he be giving a days leave without attending to his previous days "calling out" "Please inform the manager and go" was the ready made answer the assistant had which brought forth a heckling and a continuous laughter, annoying the rest of the staff as well. The previous days work remained unattended to while Sam like a cat that had just littered was pacing up and down with a leave application and a bottle of medicinal pills in his hands. In the mean time the bank had opened for business and the manager had returned to his quarters that was adjacent to the office and the happenings of the day had been duly conveyed. While entering his room he feigned surprise at Sam standing by his door - way, with a leave application form and a bottle in hand at which he demanded in his usual stern voice as to what he was doing and that whether he had attended to his days work. Before Sam could answer Thuraisamy Aiyah walked in saying that no work had been done and that the customers were awaiting to know their previous days balances. "Get me Bud on line" yelled the Manager at the telephone operator - meaning Mr. Donald perera, Manager Staff Department "Go and finish your calling out now, or go home and do not return" was the curt order. And that was that! and Sam never ever hung around the manager's room any more with a leave application or without a leave application.

Shroff Kathirvetpillai Aiyah was a class by himself and having had a telephone installed afresh at his residence was very often seen harassing the poor telephone operator for calls now and then to find out as to what kind of fish he should buy for the day, or what's up to dinner or to know which hen did lay the brown egg and which one the white and such other vital informations needed for physical structure and conditioning of his constitution. The manager one rainy afternoon, having smelt that some things was fishy had indiscreetly directed the operator to connect him the next call the Shroff asks for. Having listened for a while to the connected call he came out of the room guffawing. "I say Kathirvetpillai your daughter seems to be smarter than you" The call that the Shorff had asked for was answered by his daughter from whom he had asked as to whether it was raining at her end and when she had replied in the affirmative had further inquired whether it was raining the way it was raining at his end at which she had blurted out as to how she is to know the way in which it was raining at his end!

An incident that took place very much later after the Bank keys Have changed had more than twice lingers in my memory bringing in nostalgic mirth and smiles though there are several others this space does not permit me to relat. one Morning as I reported to office, Sellathamby, the watcher with his accustomed reddish eyes but with an unusual swollen face encountered me at the entrance requcsting a days leave. Since I was the chief clerk I inquired as to the state of his face that has swelled beyond recognition and the reason for his sudden application for leave. The story as narrated by him is given in a nut shell.

It so happened the manager had asked Ponniah to polish his quarters that was in the upstairs block so well that the floor should be neat and slippery as he was expecting some distinguished guests during the week end. Ponniah as instructed had done a perfect job or even more. Late in the night there was an urgent telephone call for the manager on the main line and it was Sellathamby who connected the call to the manager's quarters. The manager on answering the call found that the line was not clear and had asked the caller to hold on till he came down and answered him from the switch board. While hurrying down, Ponniah's Polishing made him to land on the ground floor without having to walk down the staircase. Experiencing a severe ache over the fall his fury knew no bound when he found Sellathamby holding on to the receiver of the switchboard listening to find out whether the line was still engaged with the choicest of vocabulary of all three languages put together he wrenched out the receiver from Sellathamby's hands only to find the receiver coming off lock stock and barrel from the connected loop. The rest is history and needless to say that it took more than a week for Sellathamby to report back to work.
